CULTURAL INFORMATION

Erysimum GLOW Series Perennial Wallflower

Product attributes:

A new series of hybrid perennial wallflowers with a ground-hugging, tight plant habit, and myriads of small, honey-scented flowers in a range of sunny citrus colors, flowering for weeks and weeks in early spring. Tiny foliage and very compact, the flowers appear right above the plant cushions. Very hardy and tough, these varieties provide masses of reliable color for early-season sales and make excellent rock garden or container specimens.

Assortment:

'Coral Glow': apricot-colored, strongly fragrant flowers

'Golden Glow': bright golden-yellow, honey-scented flowers

'Orange Glow' (Orange Zwerg): solid navel-orange flowers, strong fragrance

Uses:

Great for containers, as an early-season pot crop, or as a rock-garden perennial that forms beautiful mats of color over the years.

Grower Info:

Pot sizes: one liner per quart pot

Planting: pot Aug/September for Feb/March sales. Soft pinch after planting.

Soil mix: well-drained peatlite mix, neutral pH, good water and nutrient retention

Temperature: start at 65-70°F for bulking, vernalize at 35-50°F for six to eight weeks. Force to flower at 50-65°F

Light levels: high light levels recommended, no shade. Long-day treatment NOT recommended!

Crop time: ca. six months from potting to sale in northern areas, including vernalisation

PGR: GLOW varieties are very compact and bushy – they rarely require PGR treatments.

Consumer/Retail info:

A care-free plant for early-season color – the neat, mat-forming plants with small foliage are smothered with bright, sweetly-scented flowers for weeks in early spring. Sterile, so no deadheading needed. Tolerate light frosts in early spring without problems – hardy to zone 6 with protection.

Product attributes:

A new series of hybrid perennial wallflowers with a profusion of medium-sized, sweetly-scented flowers in a range of wonderful pastel colors, flowering non-stop from late through to early summer. Bushy in habit, frost-tolerant and tough, these varieties provide masses of reliable color for early-season sales. Earliest erysimum series to flower!

Assortment:

'Poem Lilac': intense lilac-purple flower spikes

'Poem Lavender': soft lavender flower spikes

'Poem Pastel': flowers open pale primrose-yellow and darken to soft lavender

'Poem Mirabelle' flowers open bright golden orange, darkening to rosy peach tones

Uses:

Great for containers, specialty bedding and mixed spring basket for early-spring sales

Grower Info:

Pot sizes: one liner per quart or per gallon pot

Planting: pot Aug/September for Feb/March sales. Soft pinch after planting.

Soil mix: well-drained peatlite mix, neutral pH, good water and nutrient retention

Temperature: start at 65-70°F for bulking, vernalize at 35-50°F for six to eight weeks. Force to flower at 50-65°F

Light levels: high light levels recommended, no shade. Long-day treatment NOT recommended!

Crop time: ca. six months from potting to sale in northern areas, including vernalisation

Crop time under high-light coastal conditions four months

PGR: recommended during bulking: spray treatment with 5 ppm Sumagic as needed. Refrain from further PGR treatments once terminal buds are well-developed to prevent compressed flower spikes.

A care-free plant for early-season color – the neat, bushy plants with dark green foliage are smothered with sweetly-scented flowers from late winter right up to hot weather in early summer. Product attributes:

A new series of hybrid perennial wallflowers with a tight plant habit, medium-sized, sweetly-scented flowers in a broad range of bright, sunny colors, flowering non-stop from late winter through to early summer. Very bushy in habit, short flower spikes, frost-tolerant and tough, these varieties provide masses of reliable color for early-season sales.

Assortment:

'Rysi Bronze': golden flowers flushed with bronze tones

'Rysi Copper': flowers open tangerine/copper and pale to golden orange

'Rysi Gold': solid chrome-yellow flowers

'Rysi Moon': flowers open cream and fade to milky white

'Rysi Star': flowers open bright acid yellow and fade to primrose

Uses:

Great for containers, specialty bedding and mixed spring basket for early-spring sales

Grower Info:

Pot sizes: one liner per quart or per gallon pot

Planting: pot Aug/September for Feb/March sales. Soft pinch after planting.

Soil mix: well-drained peatlite mix, neutral pH, good water and nutrient retention

Temperature: start at 65-70°F for bulking, vernalize at 35-50°F for six to eight weeks. Force to flower at 50-65°F

Light levels: high light levels recommended, no shade. Long-day treatment NOT recommended!

Product attributes:

A new series of hybrid perennial wallflowers with large, sweetly-scented flowers in a broad range of luscious colors, flowering non-stop from late winter through to early summer. Bushy in habit, frost-tolerant and tough, these varieties provide masses of reliable color for early-season sales.

Assortment:

'Winter Joy': intense lilac-purple flower spikes

'Winter Orchid': flowers open red, fade to deep orchid-purple

'Winter Rouge': flowers open blood-red and fade to russet

'Winter Sorbet' (Impr.): flowers open rust orange, then turn to lilac-purple

'Winter Sun': flowers open canary yellow and fade to buttercream

Uses:

Great for containers, specialty bedding and mixed spring basket for early-spring sales

Grower Info:

Pot sizes: one liner per quart or per gallon pot

Planting: pot Aug/September for Feb/March sales. Soft pinch after planting.

Soil mix: well-drained peatlite mix, neutral pH, good water and nutrient retention

Temperature: start at 65-70°F for bulking, vernalize at 35-50°F for six to eight weeks. Force to flower at 50-65°F
