C	Celery	Utah*		4-5	11-12" stalks are tender and crisp with a sweet, rich, nutty flavor. Disease resistant.
C	Eggplant	Black Beauty	288, 512	3-6	Dark purple, egg shaped fruit on 24" to 28" plants.
G	Eggplant	Fairy Tale*		3-6	Compact but bushy plants produce creamy, sweet tasting miniature eggplants. White 4-inch fruits have attractive purple streaking.
C	Eggplant	Ichiban	288, 512	3-6	Japanese type. Easy to slice. Skin is dark purple/black.
C	Eggplant	Millionaire	288, 512	3-6	Extra early and long. Japanese type. Brilliant black fruit.

C	Lettuce - Leaf	GourmetSB	288, 512	2-4	Colorful, flavorful blend of gourmet red and green leaf lettuce.

C	Pepper Hot	Anaheim	288, 512	4-6	Mildly hot and very flavorful, with slender, smooth-skinned, 8-inch dark green to red fruits. Tall, ever-bearing plants provide good foliage cover.
C	Pepper Hot	Big Jim	288, 512	4-6	7"-9" long; 2" wide at shoulders tapering to blunt end. Medium green to red when ripe. Use fresh, roasted or dried.
C	Pepper Hot	Caribbean Red	288, 512	4-6	1 1/2". Twice as hot as the commercial habanero. 350,000 to 450,000 pungency.
C	Pepper Hot	Cayenne Long Slim	288, 512	4-6	Green to red. 5" long. 3500-5000 pungency. Thin wall
C	Pepper Hot	Chili de Arbol	288, 512	4-6	2"-3" elongated, pointed fruits mature to brick red. Distinctive "tree like" plant growth.
