Super Dwarfs Patio Collection

A collection of sturdy dwarf tomatoes that combine the best characteristics of the determinate and indeterminate plant habit. The plants remain small but continue to fruit.

- ✔ Plants average about 30–36" in mature height.
- ✔ Tomatoes vary in size and shape, including fruits over 1 pound.
- ✔ Broad range of flavors—sweet, tangy, fruity and even a hint of saltiness—something to please everyone!
- ✔ Easy to grow in pots, on balconies, or wherever space is limited.

'Boronia'

Fruits up to 1 lb are produced on compact, 3 foot tall plants. Harvest massive amounts of purple fruit with delicious, intense flavor that in some seasons approaches some of the finest heirloom tomatoes. Indeterminate, 70 days



'Geranium Kiss'

Stocky plants with umbels of flowers that grow a multitude of large cherry fruits weighing about one ounce. Dwarf bush grows 24-30 inches. Excellent flavor for an early tomato, fruits can keep well for a week or two, retaining the firmness and texture. Determinate, 60 days




'Iditarod Red'

Tough as the huskies that race the Alaskan tundra, this tomato is always a winner. Tasty, 2–4 oz. juicy, red fruit is produced on stocky 3–4' plants in about 75 days. Highly recommended for container growing, but also performs superbly in the garden. Use for salads, fresh eating, drying and yummy fresh salsa. Indeterminate, 70 days



'INDIGO™ Dwarf Shadow Boxing'

Just as shadowboxing is used mainly to prepare the muscles before stronger physical activity, the fruit of this tomato is jam-packed with phytonutrients for better health. Juicy, large saladette-size fruit is an amazing kaleidoscope of colors with deep purple shoulders. Nice complex flavor on 2–3' plants. Determinate, 72 days



'Perth Pride'

This 3–4 foot tall plant produces 3–5 oz. tomatoes with excellent flavor. Fruits are blemish free, smooth, round, and ripen to a deep purple color. Taste is full and rich with a distinct, refreshing tartness. Indeterminate 70 days



'Rosella Purple'

Medium to large (6–12 oz.) deep purple-pink fruit on productive sturdy plants. Flavor rivals 'Cherokee Purple', but on a dwarf 3–4 feet tall plant! Flavor is full, intense, balanced and delicious. Indeterminate, 58 days



'Sleeping Lady'

Named after a legend in Alaskan folklore, this trusty variety is a saga of its own! A mid-season variety that has stocky, central stems, grows to three feet tall, and has dark green, rugose, regular leaf foliage. The 3–6 oz. fruits ripen to a chocolate-mahogany color with excellent flavor that is well balanced and delightful. Indeterminate, 60 days



'Tasmanian Chocolate'

This mid-season tomato provides the color, size and shape of 'Paul Robeson', but on a dwarf growing plant that is 3–4 feet tall, perfect for a large pot, and yields tomatoes until frost. Fruits range from 5–12 oz. and ripen to a deep mahogany color. Flavor is full, balanced and delicious. Indeterminate, 60 days
